Complication or Sick Animal Charges if Applicable

There may be additional complications or sick animal charges after your pet's surgery, and you are responsible for these. Here is a list of some of the common charges but there may be others. Each pet's need is different.

-Cryptorchid \$20-50 and up	Extractions (per tooth) \$10
-Hernia Repair \$20 and up	-Hydrometra/Pyometra (infections) \$60-\$120
-In Heat \$20	-Antibiotics \$25-50
-Pregnancy \$10-\$50	-Flea Treatment (Capstar-kills live fleas) \$8-10

If you prefer to get a Rabies Vaccine prior to surgery, you can get a 1 Year Rabies vaccine for \$5 (cash only) at the Davie County Animal Shelter during their regular business hours, Tue-Fri 9am-3pm
